



Three Methods of becoming a Registered Member

One method of becoming a Registered Member is by going through our Competency Review process (<https://homeopathy.org/product/nash-competency-review-application/>) which includes providing us with the following documentation:

- high school graduate with appropriate post-secondary education including approved courses in medical sciences and psychology,
- verification of half or full-time practice of classical homeopathy for a minimum of two years,
- a minimum of 500 hours of training in homeopathy through recognized teachers or institutions recognized in the field of classical homeopathy,
- ten cured chronic cases with six months follow-up (guidelines are found on the website),
- a curriculum vitae,
- a written description of his/her practice and style of practice,
- two personal references and two professional references,
- and any other specific information decreed necessary by the Society.

The complete details and the application can be found on our website.

Neither certification nor registration is a legal requirement, these processes allows us to promote our Registered Members who have proven to have high standards necessary for a homeopathic practice.

Another way to become a Registered Member is to go through the certification process of the Council for Homeopathic Certification (CHC). To get detailed information about the CHC, please visit their web site - www.homeopathicdirectory.com. If you decide to get a certification through The Council for Homeopathic Certification, NASH requires 5 independent cases to be submitted with your application for Registered Membership. The Council for Homeopathic Certification offers verification of competency in homeopathy and is not a license to practice.

The third method of becoming a Registered Member is to be a current member of one of a number of reciprocating Society's in other countries whose registration process equals or exceeds the previously discussed methods. You would need to be able to verify your membership status is any of these organizations:

- Ontario Registration
 - Irish Society of Homeopaths
 - The Society of Homeopaths (UK)
 - Australian Homoeopathic Association
 - Alliance of Registered Homeopaths (UK)
 - New Zealand Council of Homeopaths
 - State Councils of Homeopathy (India)
